- 7) Cadets to bring sleeping bags, pads, and other bedding. If you have a cot, bring it.
- 8) Color guard equipment required for this training, including method of playing National Anthem on DVD
- 9) Did you learn anything at leadership training, be prepared for weather.
- 10) Steamer for Neck Ties: We have several new neckties available for inspection. We need a small garment steamer to freshen them up.
