FUTURE DRILLS

- 2) SCUBA OPEN WATER DIVES:
WHERE: 41 North take the Velp exit and go left (West). Take this to the first set of lights. There is an A&W here. This is Riverview. Take this to the right (North). Follow this past Rivers Bend Restaurant, past the curve and over the next cross street. There is an enclosed quarry in a fence. We will meet at the top of the hill just inside the gate as I am only allowed by the water's edge.
WHEN: 05 – 06 June Arrival time of 1000 with departure of 1300
- 3) LIGHTHOUSE WALK: The Door County Maritime Museum needs cadets to help with the Lighthouse Walk. 12-13 June. Berthing at the USCG Canal Station. Escort Officers will be needed.
