The purpose of this letter is to introduce the Green Bay Division of the U.S. Naval Sea Cadets. We are officially known as the VADM James H. Flatley Jr. Division. Our unit was formed in 2001 and named after Admiral Flatley, a Green Bay native.

Since 1958 the Naval Sea Cadet Corps, through organization and cooperation with the Department of the Navy and Coast Guard, has been committed to encourage and aid American youth to develop their leadership abilities, train them in seagoing skills, and to teach them patriotism, courage, self-reliance and kindred virtues, broaden their horizons through hands-on training and guide them to becoming mature young adults.

The local Navy Operations and Support Center (NOSC) provides our cadets with classroom space where we meet one weekend per month. Our unit is primarily funded by donations, enrollment fees and yearly dues.

Our cadets depend heavily on classroom instruction, Navy correspondence courses, and on-line testing advancement. It is important to note that the course work required to advance places a large academic demand on our cadets. Our cadets, at age 13-19, study the same material as enlisted Navy personnel. The testing is identical and is actually conducted on-line using the same system as the regular Navy.

During a typical year, direct costs to cadets include but are not limited to the items listed below. These items may be underwritten as scholarships.

1. ENROLLMENT: \$250
2. YEARLY DUES: \$75
3. 1 WEEK SUMMER TRAINING: \$125
4. 2 WEEK SUMMER TRAINING: \$250
5. AIRFARE / TRAVEL: \$75 ~ \$250
6. CHIEF SCHOLARSHIP, USED TO PURCHASE UNIFORMS AND SUPPLIES FOR CADETS WHO ATTAIN THE HIGHEST RANK, CHIEF PETTY OFFICER: \$200
