TO: NEWLY ENROLLED (USNSCC) CADETS AND PARENTS

At the March drill all newly enrolled USNSCC cadets received their “dress white uniform” which included: pants, jumper, neckerchief, and if a male a white belt – males use utility belt buckle (silver) on dress white belt.

- 1) Please get the pants fitted, i.e. do not leave the pants too long. The bottom of the pant should rest at the top of the heel. (do not leave them too long as white does not come clean from dragging on the deck as you march and drill plus the dragging makes the pants very hard for you to clean and reflects on you as a cadet.)
- 2) Wash the complete uniform and make sure it is clean and is “white”. This may take some work as they may be looking more grey than white from being in storage so long.
- 3) If you are in need of flashes for the left and right shoulders of the jumper **let me know** and I will have some for you. They are sewn on like the utility shirt... 1 inch down from the shoulder and centered on the sleeve. 1 inch down from the shoulder on each side – measure! Eagle faces – front!
- 4) Have ***pride*** in your uniform. We will have whites brought to our next drill and see how your uniform looks. We are preparing for summer boot camp and advanced trainings.
- 5) Whites become the dress uniform as of the month of April. Dress Blues are stored until fall - September.
